## HYDRO C - HOOK OIL (SOLVENT TYPE HOOK OIL)

### MATERIAL & FUNCTION

**HYDRO C - HOOK OIL** is a solvent based product designed as a dewatering oil, and rust preventative for hooks and rollers in abattoirs and other meat establishments.

### FEATURES

Effectively lubricates hooks and rollers. Protects against rusting. Does not build up or form hard surface coatings and remains easy to clean and maintain.

### APPEARANCE

Clear to light yellow liquid.

### APPLICATION

Use neat in a 200L to 400L holding tank. Dip the basket full of cast iron or s/s hooks in for approximately 1 minute to 10 minutes depending on the state of the hooks. Make sure a thorough rinse in warm to hot water is done after the acid stage and before the oil stage.

### PERFORMANCE CHARACTERISTICS

This product is intended to be applied to hooks after the cleaning process to leave a thin film of oil which reduces surface rusting. It is not intended for direct contact with food product but may incur incidental contact.
